





# Characteristics...






# Mineral Marks

Dark or discolored area caused by minerals that the tree extracts from the water or soil; can appear as a streak or a stain. Mineral Marks have varying degrees of darkness from very light to nearly black. Also known as mineral deposits, sugar deposits or dark marks.







# **Knotty Pine**

Knotty Pine material contains markings that are more extreme than in standard products.









The direction, size and appearance of wood fibers vary greatly depending on where the wood is cut from within the tree. The type, direction and density of the grain is unique within each piece of wood, thus creating a truly individual pattern.

Flat Grain





Markings that indicate the location of branches. They vary in size, shape, and color.



Burl

Formed from an irregular growth on the outer edge of the tree. Also known as Birds Eye.
